

Ing. Ugo Dell’Arciprete got a degree in Telecom Engineering at Politecnico of Milan in 1974.

After his military duty he joined in 1977 the IT Dept of FS where, until 1996, was responsible for different sectors (operations, SW development, capacity planning, ...); from 1977 to 1979 he was a member of the Hermes project team which designed the first Hermes network.



in 1996 he joined the Passenger Division of Trenitalia, where he worked mainly as an IT consultant, collecting the commercial needs of the Division and translating them into technical specifications. Among others he was project leader for the development of Railbest, former Trenitalia's web-based distribution system.

All along his career he has co-operated with countless UIC, CER and CIT bodies. From 1997 to 2004 he was secretary of the UIC Distribution & Systems Group, from 2005 to 2010 chairman of the same body (now Technical Group). From 2007 to 2010 he has been one of the three CER speakers who have written the TAP TSI Regulation.

At the end of 2010 he went to retirement as Trenitalia manager, but continued as a consultant for both the UIC, as member of the project team implementing Phase One of the TAP TSI, and for Hit Rail, where he is currently Commercial Manager.
